Thank you, on behalf of United Way Niagara Falls and Greater Fort Erie and United Way South Niagara, for participating as a Cart & Tee sponsor of the 16<sup>th</sup> Annual United Way Golf Classic. The tournament raised \$25,000! That's a \$5000 increase over last year! These funds will be invested into 56 local programs and services that support children, youth, families, seniors and the most vulnerable citizens in our community.

## Here are some examples of how your support helped benefit the community last year:

- 11,182 hot meals were delivered to shut-ins and the elderly
- 9,681 hungry school children received meals through nutrition programs
- 200 individuals in crisis received immediate mental health care at a drop-in clinic
- 150 women fleeing abuse (with a total of 142 children) received emergency shelter and support
- 46 autistic children attended summer camp; participating in recreational, social and life skills activities in a safe and supportive environment
- 36 individuals recovering from addiction were provided up to a year of residency in transitional housing where they received specialized support, guidance and counselling
